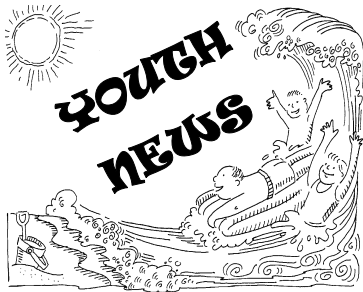
The Virginia Annual Conference is being held in Norfolk, Virginia at the Scope Arena, June 14 thru 17, 2009.
