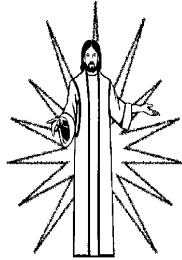

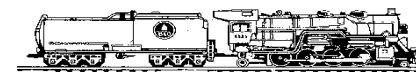


Summer Music
